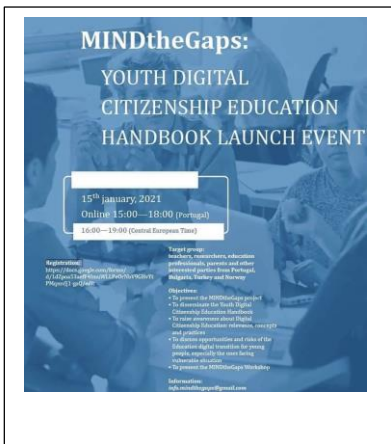

At 15th January, 2021, teachers, researchers, education professionals, parents and other interested parties from Portugal, Bulgaria, Turkey and Norway attended this event, whose objectives were to present the MINDtheGaps project, to disseminate the Youth Digital Citizenship Education Handbook, to raise awareness about Digital Citizenship Education: relevance, concepts and practices, to discuss opportunities and risks of the Education digital transition for young people, especially the ones facing vulnerable situation and to present the MINDtheGaps Workshop.



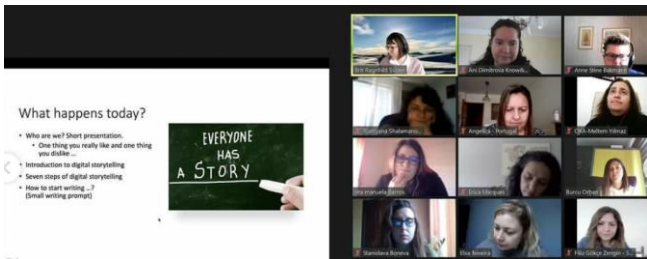
MINDtheGaps AMONG THE MOST INSPIRING PROJECTS

"DIGITAL STORYTELLING" – WORKSHOP FOR FACILITATORS

Teachers who will play the role of facilitators with young people in the process of building multimedia educational resources attended a six sessions workshop, spread over March April, between 12 am and 2 pm (CET time). All the 14 participants, from Portugal, Turkey and Bulgaria, were guided by INN University in Norway, a partner with a long experience with digital storytelling and the video editing tool (WeVideo) used for making the facilitators' stories.



THE FIRST LOCAL YOUTH "DIGITAL STORYTELLING" WORKSHOPS

The first "Digital Storytelling" Workshops was carried out with 22 young people from Turkey. The Portuguese team started with a presential workshop with six young people from a local association, but all agendas had to be cancelled due to pandemic restrictions. Despite everything, the young people were very involved in the video production activities and the results were very promising. At the beginning of the school year, new workshops with young people will continue this work!



MINDtheGaps PUBLIC PRESENTATION – WEBINAR: 7 DIAS COM OS MEDIA

"Media literacy and inequalities" was the theme of the webinar that the Informal Group on Media Literacy (GILM) promotes, in the context of the 9th edition of the National Operation 7 Days with Media, which takes place between 3 and 9 May 2021. During this virtual meeting the debate focus on Media literacy: Inclusive pathways for an active citizenship, and the MINDtheGaps Project made an excellent contribution with a presentation by its Coordinator, Professor Angélica Monteiro.
